The Scottish Trans Alliance is Scotland's national project working to improve gender identity and gender reassignment equality and human rights. We are part of the Equality Network.

We give expert guidance and training to service providers, employers, and equality organisations on policy, best practice, and how they can become more trans inclusive.

We conduct internationally-recognised transgender research, where we engage with the community to provide the evidence-base we need to argue for change. Some focuses of our research have been mental health, non-binary, and Gender Identity Clinics.

We hold skills development events around the country for trans activists on topics such as healthcare, employment

and legal gender recognition. This ensures that trans people from across the community have the knowledge and skills they need to advocate for the changes they want to see in Scotland.

Our work at a strategic level has helped to significantly improve the lives of trans people in Scotland, such as securing:

- Fully inclusive transgender hate crime legislation
- Equal marriage legislation that fully addresses the needs of transgender people
- The most progressive gender reassignment treatment pathway in Europe
- Trans-inclusive women's organisations and domestic abuse and rape crisis services
